Kohl's \$750,000 Donation to Hunger Task Force Supports the Provision of Healthy Food to Milwaukee Families in Need

Kohl's donation provides hundreds of thousands of pounds of healthy food and supports expansion of organization's MyPlate program

MENOMONEE FALLS, Wis., January 14, 2020 – [Kohl's](#) (NYSE: KSS) announced today, in support of its overall commitment to family health and wellness, a donation of \$750,000 to Hunger Task Force, ensuring a steady supply of healthy food to Milwaukee-area families. Through Kohl's donation and the expansion of the Hunger Task Force MyPlate program – a healthy eating model based upon USDA nutrition recommendations – the nearly 50,000 Milwaukee-area residents Hunger Task Force serves monthly will be provided the right types and portions of foods to consume daily to improve their health and wellness.
